- Personally deal with any issues that have caused friction, upset or hurt and if unresolved asking a leader to be involved.
- Be committed to the role that I have volunteered for, by being reliable, arriving on time, doing the work to the best of my ability, speaking to my team leader about any issues or suggestions.

I have read and will act in accordance with my role description, including reading and applying any policies and procedures mentioned within it.

I will do my utmost to prevent abuse and neglect among those involved in or attending The King's Church, Wisbech activities and services.

I will do my utmost to keep myself and others safe from physical dangers, performing any tasks sensibly in accordance with any training or risks assessments given.

I will accept personal responsibility to protect those involved in or attending church activities by being alert to inappropriate behaviour and reporting any incidents or concerns quickly to a Safeguarding lead or an Overseer.

I will endeavour, where possible, to be a source of help to individuals or families in which abuse and/or neglect has been experienced.
