First Aid	Every one attending	<ul> <li>First aid box taken with church.</li> <li>Two designated first aiders on site.</li> <li>Other trained staff able to assist.</li> </ul>	
Trip hazards	Anyone attending	<ul> <li>Signs will be put up warning of trip hazards. People will be warned in notices before the event.</li> </ul>	Remove any trip hazard that can easily be removed
Injury from Nettles and Brambles	Anyone attending	<ul> <li>Signs will be put up warning of trip hazards. People will be warned in notices before the event.</li> </ul>	
Food Poisoning	Anyone attending. Eating food that has gone off	<ol> <li>On arrival food will be store in cool place.</li> <li>Cooks will ensure all food is properly cooked before serving.</li> <li>Cooked food will be eaten within 1 hour.</li> <li>Food prepared by congregation will be eaten within 3 hours of the meeting starts.</li> <li>All food will be checked by church staff before being served.</li> <li>At least one person with food hygiene level 2 will be supervising the event.</li> </ol>	
Allergens	Anyone with an allergy.	<ul> <li>Everyone bring food will be asked to complete an allergen form and hand it to staff on arrival.</li> <li>All allergen cards will be placed next to food it refers to.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Additional allergen cards will be available on the day if lost.</li> <li>People will be warned to take care with what they eat if they have an allergy.</li> </ul>
Bouncy castle	People using the castle.	<ul><li>A separate bouncy castle risk assessment will be written.</li><li>Bouncy castle hired from reputable organisation.</li></ul>	• Supervision will be supplied by volunteers on the day.



BBQing	People cooking. People accidentally touching BBQ	<ul> <li>Only people who have been trained to use the BBQ or own the BBQ can use it.</li> <li>Area where the BBQs are will be cordoned off from general access.</li> </ul>	• Supervision of site around BBQs on the day.
Toilet facilities	Issues due to lack of Toilets	• 1 toilet has been hired for the event. This will be installed professionally.	
Electrical injury from equipment	People using equipment	<ul> <li>Properly earthed power cable installed.</li> <li>Equipment PAT tested.</li> <li>Equipment not used in the rain or if wet.</li> </ul>	N / A this year
Manual Handling	People moving equipment around site	<ul> <li>All people moving equipment must have had manual handling training or be supervised by someone with manual handling training.</li> </ul>	
Parking for event	People parking cars	All congregation have access to information about safe parking areas.
